Crowds Tips & Tricks

- * **When to Visit**—if you are looking for low crowds, the best time to visit is between January and early March.
- * **Park Opening**—Arrive at the park early, the lines are shorter and the parks are not as crowded.
- * **When it Rains**—Put on a poncho and hit the attractions—the lines are low as guests tend to leave the park.

Dining Tips & Tricks

- * **Advanced Reservations**—Be sure to make your reservations in advance to secure your must-do dining—currently you can make them 60 days prior to your visit.
- * **Check the Day Of**—If you had trouble getting a reservation prior to your trip be sure to check with the restaurant for last minute availability, we recommend checking early in the day for availability.

Money Savings Tips & Tricks

- * **Gift Cards**—Purchase discounted gift cards at Target or Sam's Club to use at the parks.
- * **Adults**—don't be afraid to order off the kids menu especially if you have a small appetite.
- * **Ponchos**—purchase them at your local Dollar Store, this is a big savings and you can just throw them out before you head back home.

More Tips & Tricks

- * **Rider Swap**—Have little ones not tall enough to ride, let the Cast Member know you need a Rider Swap.
- * **Stroller**—Have a stroller tie a ribbon around it so you can easily identify it in the “sea of strollers.”
- * **Shoes**—Wear a good pair of walking shoes however we recommend if it's raining, flip flops, as your shoes will get pretty wet. Pack them in backpack then swap out when the rain starts.
- * **Phone Charger**—Be sure to pack a portable charger, chances are you will be using your phone throughout the day for lots of photos!
